General Instructions:

- 1. **Age**: Preferably below 35 years for the post of Assistant Professor Gr. II, 45 years for Assistant Professor Gr. I and 50 years for Associate Professor. Age relaxation is applicable as prescribed by the Government of India from time to time.
- 2. Reservation is applicable as per the norms of the Government of India. The candidates are required to submit the Caste/Category/Disabilities Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the format prescribed by the Government of India for this purpose.
- 3. All applications will be acknowledged by email. The applicant is expected to have a valid and live email ID. If an acknowledgment is not received within one week, an email may be sent to the *fsupport23@iiitkottayam.ac.in*. Further communications will be sent through email only, to the short-listed candidates. No other mode of communication will be adopted.
- 4. The application has to be submitted only through the web portal of the Institute as per instruction given in the website (https://recruitf.iiitkottayam.ac.in/). Incomplete applications and applications not supported by relevant documents as claimed in the application will be summarily rejected. If a candidate is applying for more than one post, separate applications should be submitted for each post and prescribed fee should be paid alongwith each application.
- 5. No hard-copy of the application or supported documents need to be sent to the Institute. Candidates working on regular basis under the Central Govt. /State Govt/Public Sector-Undertakings/ Central Autonomous Bodies etc. have to attach a 'No Objection Certificate' from the current employer alongwith the application form.
- 6. Date for determining the eligibility of all candidates in every respect shall be the prescribed closing date for submission on online recruitment application.
- 7. The prescribed qualification and experience are the minimum and the mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for interview. The other essential and desirable requirements will be as prescribed for faculty positions in IIITs under the four-tier faculty structure. IIIT Kottayam follows the four-tier flexible faculty structure approved by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India.
- 8. A duly constituted committee will shortlist the candidates to be called for the selection process comprising of written test/seminar and/or interview. Shortlisted candidates will be required to give a seminar/ presentation prior to or during the interview. No interim enquires/ correspondences/ communication of any sort will be entertained in the matter.
- 9. Candidates who are further shortlisted for face-to-face interview will be paid the travelling expenses, from home station/place of duty/port of disembarkation within India, restricted to AC III tier class in Indian Railways, on production of valid tickets.
- 10. The faculty appointed on regular faculty cadre will be on probation for a period of one year. Confirmation in service after the period of probation will be subject to the assessment of performance as per the prescribed criteria and verification of antecedents.
- 11. In addition to the pay and allowances, benefits like leave, NPS, medical reimbursement etc. will be available as admissible to, in line with the service conditions as contained under the IIIT (PPP) Act & Statutes, as amended from time to time to the faculty appointed in regular faculty cadre. Those who appointed as Assistant Professor Gr. II will not be entitled for benefits as applicable for faculty appointed on regular cadre like NPS etc. However, they will be provided with leave as applicable to regular faculty members. They will have to apply afresh against the Institute advertisement in case they wish to come under the regular faculty cadre.

- 12. Faculty appointed on regular cadre will be covered under the NPS, as notified by the Government of India.
- 13. The advertised qualifications, experience and other credentials are the minimum for the positions.
